Following Gail Abrahamson's recent letters, we have seen Mrs Wintle again to discuss her haemostatic cover for her lipoma removal. We have decided that it would be better to use, factor VIII concentrate electively. She mentioned that this procedure may be more extensive than first thought. She seems quite happy with this idea. We are checking her immunity to Hepatitis B and should have the results fairly soon. I gather that she is coming into hospital on October 3rd for operation on October 4th. We would plan to treat her with factor VIII about 1½ hours before her surgery, giving us time to check her response to the infusion. She would need treatment thereafter for three to four days, depending on the extent of the surgery; if it is a deep procedure she could require quite a considerably longer period of cover with factor VIII.

I would appreciate it if she could be put on the list towards late morning for early afternoon to enable us to fit in her factor VIII assays.
