Dear Mrs. GRO-B

I believe you have requested some information from GRO-B notes regarding Hepatitis C.

GRO-B was transferred to us from Yorkhill Hospital and first attended our unit in September 1988.

We do not have records of treatments used at Yorkhill Hospital.

His treatment records at the Royal Infirmary are as follows:

- 1988 – Desmopressin and Human Factor VIII Z8 – SNBTS.
- 1997 – Desmopressin.
- 1998 – Desmopressin and Recombinate.
- 1998 – 4 units red cells (blood transfusion).
- 1999 – Desmopressin.
- 2001 – Recombinate.
- 2002 – Recombinate.
- 2003 – Desmopressin.
- 2005 – Advate.
- 2009 – Advate.
- 2010 – Helixate Next Gen.

GRO-B was tested for Hepatitis C on 7/11/95.

He was given his results by Prof. Lowe on 5/12/95.

His genotype was 1.

We are unable to say when GRO-B was infected with Hepatitis C or by which product in the past. However, we think it most likely he was infected prior to transfer to the Royal Infirmary.

I hope that the information above that we have been able to provide is helpful.
