Your patient with severe haemophilia complicated by an inhibitor was admitted on 26th May via Prince Charles Hospital having injured his left knee. This settled on Factor VIII replacement by the time of discharge on 12th June, was only slightly swollen and no limitation of flexion.

As an aside, he developed spontaneous oral candidiasis and was noted to have lymphopenia, lymphadenopathy and splenomegaly. It remains a distinct possibility that he is developing the acquired immune deficiency syndrome (A.I.D.S) and we shall review him more carefully in the Outpatient clinic. Obviously we have not discussed this with him as it would inevitably lead to major alarm.

He is to reattend in two weeks.
