Heat Treated Factor VIII and IX Concentrate

I have obtained the following ^{names} of HTLV III antibody negative haemophiliac children from my paediatricians:-

We have one other haemophiliac child who is HTLV III antibody positive -

but I presume that you would not be willing to supply him with heat-treated Factor VIII concentrate on the grounds that his HTLV III result may be a false positive.

We have one child with severe Christmas disease who is HTLV III negative and so far untreated GRO-A d.o.b. GRO-A 84, Hosp. No. GRO-A for whom I would wish to have heat-treated factor IX concentrate as and when it becomes available. Dr. Snape suggested in a letter dated 7th February, 1985 that this product might be available for clinical use in July of this year.
