but I presume that you would not be willing to supply him with heat-treated Factor VIII concentrate on the grounds that his HTL VIII result may be a false positive.

We have one child with severe Christmas disease who is HTLV III negative and so far untreated **GRO-A** d.o.b.**GRO-A**84, Hosp. No. **GRO-A**) for whom I would wish to have heat-treated factor IX concentrate as and when it becomes available. Dr. Snape suggested in a letter dated 7th February, 1985 that this product might be available for clinical use in July of this year.
