As I hoped when we last met, we have been able to make end of year payments to both Trusts. These total £2.75m:

£2.25m for the Macfarlane Trust Fund. This replaces the £2m you were due to receive from the Department in 2002/2003.

£0.5m for the Eileen Trust fund.

A decision will be taken later this year (probably in the Autumn) about the

level of payments to the Macfarlane Trust Fund from 2003/2004.

I look forward to meeting you again on 23 April for the Trustee interviews.
