

. APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

An apology was received from Professor O'Grady.

2. CONFIDENTIALITY

The Chairman reminded members that the material they received was of a highly confidential nature and should not be made available to outside contacts.

3. MINUTES OF THE MEETING HELD ON WEDNESDAY 10 SEPTEMBER 1975

The minutes were agreed and signed by the Chairman.

- 4. MATTERS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES
- (a) Paper CSM/BSC/75/10 was presented showing the recommendations of the Sub-Committee on Toxicity, Clinical Trials and Therapeutic Efficacy and the decisions of the Main Committee on those biological products which had been considered at the last meeting of the Sub-Committee. Members were advised that the application in respect of Arvin (Ancrod) PL/0152/0099 had been referred to the last meeting of the TCT Sub-Committee but had been withdrawn from the agenda pending clarification of the indications for use.
- (b) Professor Evans reported that the Immunological Products Advisory Committee had considered the control procedures in respect of Human Diploid Cell Rabies Vaccine (FL/0012/0106) and Tick-borne Encephalitis Virus Vaccine (PL/0487/0001) and had forwarded their views to the Secretariat for discussion with the manufacturers concerned.
- 5. CONSIDERATION OF APPLICATIONS

Applications for six product licences and one clinical trial certificate were considered. The preparations concerned and the Sub-Committee's recommendations are set out in Appendix A to these minutes. The application in respect of Symmetrel (PL/CCC1/CCC1) was withdrawn from the agenda, since the company had decided to cmit the indications of influenza in children.

6. APPLICATIONS PREVIOUSLY DEFERRED

Two applications that had been deferred for further information at the meeting of 12 March 1975 were considered. The preparations concerned and the Sub-Committee's recommendations are included in Appendix A to these minutes.

7. INTEGRATION OF VIRAL GENOMES (Paper CSM/BSC/75/9)

This paper drew the attention of members to an article by V M Zhdanov that had appeared in 'Nature' on 7 August 1975 suggesting that certain autoimmune diseases were manifestations of viral information integrated into host cells through the co-operation of latent cucornaviruses.
