Mrs. & Mrs. Nichols reported appointment to discuss Hep-C. - very disturbed by report in frontline.
 This was curious if his associated with Hep-C.
 Lab tests ordered.
 Denied at start as other way of minimizing problem
 and interferon as possible treatment.
 No evidence to suggest monoclonal cause for concern
 but he will be followed very closely.
 Nicholas has left about for the present. Present prostate
stage is Sept. waiting for parent's consent.
 (Treated for 3/52 before which this intended point): GRO-C

Revised (Ordered abx + multivitamins). GRO-C urine:

Mr. Nichols felt they were "one big happy family," now. Offered
 agreed. Nicholas has lost his interest, and because he
 is less "lazy" is shorted at less off of him. Because
 there is less drinking GRO-C no longer feels it necessary
 to drop it.

In spite of all this goodwill + some joking about, Nichols
 looked quite red and worn for part of the time.
 Refusal to hypothetical was clearly not wanted by the
 parents - this was not praised. Nicholas said he
 vaguely remembered drinking it last year.

Nicholas likes visiting here because "every time he comes"
 he finds something new, wrong with him.

Denied HBV + small liver enlargement.

Bleeds approx. once a week, miscellaneous sites; no
 bright spots, beyond 6 or 8 days of use.
 Bleed into left wrist this morning, following a knock,
 treated before coming here. Not into the joint.

No problems with varicose veins. Finds difficulty when
 lie down + bleed into his head/hands.

General health good.

Mrs. Hinkle obtained repeat prescription for iron tabs, but she is not taking any at present.
Joints don't regularly.

Starting at 6th from College (Duff & Wiles) in September.

Plans to write back's - 1 year.

GRO-C is happy at school. Writes back's next year.

Age 11t. 174 cm. wt 48.6.

HT is steady on 75th centile, but wt. has declined
from 85th to 10th centile

Has very prominent thyroid. Father has same anatomical
feature - says it was his biggest problem when young.
Difficult to decide whether thyroid is normal in size.

B.P. 110/60. Pulse 68 regular. Skin pale + puffy.

Month healthy

No lymphadenopathy

Chest clear.

Abdomen - liver + spleen not palpable
no masses.

time as blood count + Fe in 3/12. (T3 T4 TSH + Thyroid antibodies)

HT. Steady on 75 centile wt dropping - now on 10th centile.

Eats poor diet + less like night. Has grown 10 cm. in past
year.

If TSH ↑ at next check refer Dr. Gontoux.
