It is clear that his prophylactic factor VIII replacement is haphazard (one to two times a week) and, therefore, consideration for hepatitis C therapy is essentially irrelevant, as it requires a fair amount of patient compliance. Self-injecting subcutaneously three times a week, as well as regular oral medication. Mr Wherry is well aware of this situation and agreed that he would need to be compliant with his factor VIII replacement prior to commencing hepatitis C combination therapy.

He has an outpatient appointment in the combined clinic in six months time and will have an ultrasound and blood tests before then.
