INFECTED BLOOD INQUIRY

SECOND WRITTEN STATEMENT OF ROWENA JECOCK

I, ROWENA JECOCK will say as follows:-

- 1. I am making this second statement following a Rule 13 request dated 4 April 2022, which notified me that I was subject to criticism in the written statement of Peter Stevens of 27 January 2021 (at paragraph 164 of his statement).
- 2. The criticism, made by Peter Stevens in relation to my role as Head of Policy, Blood Safety & Supply at the Department of Health, was that I asked him for a copy of the document entitled "Scheme of payments for those infected with HIV through blood or tissue transfer" because the Department of Health could not find it. I have also responded to this criticism at section 88 of my third and main statement, but am responding separately in this second statement at the request of the Inquiry.
- 3. Mr Stevens was correct to say that I had asked for a copy of this document. The DH hard copy files for the Eileen Trust contained a copy of the Scottish scheme document, but I had not been able to find one for England, Wales and Northern Ireland. I do not remember exactly when I first realised the document was missing, but it would have been after I took over the AHO sponsorship business. I would likely have consulted my predecessor about the whereabouts of the document, although I do not specifically remember a conversation. My assumption was that the document had been misfiled. I continued to look for it as and when my team recalled hard copy files from the archive. I am sure it was some considerable time later when I eventually requested a copy from Mr Stevens, presumably when it became necessary to refer to it for a particular matter.
