## INTERVIEW OF WITNESS

Doctor F.M. HENDERSON was telephonically interviewed by this investigator on 8-12-86 at approximately 11:30 a.m. in regard to information received by this investigator from the Arkansas State Medical Board. The information pertained to three doctors, one of which was a student at the time of his working for HMA, Inc. at Pine Bluff.

This investigator identified the three doctors in questioned as medical student GARY TANNER of Little Rock, LLOYD CAAUWE, M.D. formally of Pine Bluff, and HENRY IRBY, M.D. also formally of Pine Bluff. This investigator asked Doctor HENDERSON if he would go through the history of each of these physicians with this investigator and provide dates, if available, as to the times that these individuals worked for HENDERSON as well as problems that may have existed and circumstances of that employment.

In regards to GARY TANNER, Doctor HENDERSON stated that he had acquired Doctor TANNER (graduated medical student but not licensed) in early 1986 as a graduate medical student who had not yet passed the FLEX. Doctor HENDERSON stated to this investigator that he used TANNER as his direct assistant and in the capacity of a Physicians Assistant in the treating of In-Patients at the Diagnostic Hospital at the Diagnostic Center. Doctor HENDERSON stated that that was the only capacity that he used Doctor TANNER in as Doctor TANNER was not yet formally licensed by the State Medical Board. Doctor HENDERSON did note that Doctor TANNER had recently obtained a passing score on his Medical Board exams and had since been formally licensed by the state. Doctor HENDERSON stated that he had lost Doctor TANNER to the military this summer.
