## Margaret Madden Re:

I enclose a part two form for Margaret Madden deceased. Her trustees were apparently sent the part two form in error so I have done my best with this. No one has suggested this lady had severe liver disease so a part one form would have been more appropriate. Her notes have been destroyed long since. I attach print outs of her ultra sound reports and a computer record of her positive HCV. You will see that she already features on the computer list of HCV positive patients that I sent the Skipton Fund some time ago.

By way of background and since the wrong form was sent, this lady was an extreme rarity in that she had severe haemophilia A with a factor VIII level of less than 1% since her mother was a carrier of severe haemophilia and her father had severe haemophilia. They were unrelated. She required factor VIII replacement therapy throughout her life and contracted Hepatitis C from her treatment in the late 60's or early 70's. Her liver function tests were chronically abnormal and when HCV testing came along we tested her and she tested positive. HCV is not mentioned on her death certificate since it was not a contributory cause of death and her regular ultrasounds as part of the monitoring of her Hepatitis C did not ever indicate serious underlying liver disease. I think she is therefore eligible for a part one payment.
