Dear Peter,

As we discussed previously on the phone, I have just treated two virgin haemophiliacs with alpha heat treated FVIII. The details of the two patients are as follows:

GRO-A PVIIIC -- 0.12 iu/ml

This going man who works around the corner from the Middlesex Hospital feell off this bike and was infused with 7,800 units of alpha heat treated factor that over the course of four days, starting on May 13th. He had never before received any blood products. He has agreed to be followed up at formightly intervals for the next year.

Luke O'SHEA-PHILLIPS dob GRO-C 81 FVIIIC - 0.20 iu/ml

This young boy fell over and hit his mouth and upper teeth on the ground and when I first saw him they had been intermittently bleeding for 3 days. As an infusion of DDAVP had not controlled the bleeding he then received 1,680 units of alpha heat treated FVIII concentrate. This 'oy also was a virgin and had never received any blood products in his ife.

Both patients received Profilate List Number 360210, Lot Number A6-0311. Both patients will attend for fortnightly follow-up blood samples, for liver function tests, blood count and virology. I hope they will be suitable for the heat treated trial.
