This gentleman who has moderately severe Haemophilia A was reviewed at the Haemophilia Unit on 19th April, 1994. His previous problems have mainly affected the left knee, which is much improved since arthroscopy in 1993. The left quadriceps muscle is now almost built up to normal. None of his other joints are severely affected. He last had to use Factor VIII in July of 1993 at the time of the arthroscopy. He has had no bleeds over the last nine months. Routine bloods were performed and were all within normal limits, in particular the liver function tests were normal. As you know, this patient is anti-HCV positive; which has been confirmed by RIBA-2. He was counselled as regards Hepatitis C and advised to use barrier methods of contraception; although was also reassured that the chance of sexual transmission is relatively low. He will be reviewed at the clinic in six months time.
