Re: **GRO-B**

I saw **GRO-B** for the first time with his mother at the Haemophilia Clinic on 28.10.83. His baseline factor VKIII level is 8% as measured by the laboratory at the **GRO-B**. He has had several bleeds approximately one a month in the past year or so usually due to some minor tremor which has occurred while he has been at school. His dentition is good but I note he has had some trouble with bleeding with dental work in the past. These bleeds usually occur into his right thigh and left knee. While he has no obvious problem with haemophilic arthropathy he apparently suffers from chondromalacia patellae of his left knee. He appears to be good academically and is studying for his 'O' grades this year. Because of this I feel he would be an excellent candidate for home treatment. He could then treat himself should the need arise and this would of course reduce any time that he would lose from school which is obviously important round the time of his 'O' grades and Highers. We will therefore arrange for this to be done.
