I saw this patient with moderately severe haemophilia A at the Haemophilia Clinic on 27 03 92. He has been reasonably well since his last visit to the Clinic, his only problem being a recurrent problem with his right ankle for which he is attending the Orthopaedic Surgeons. I note that he is due to have a CT scan this coming Monday to identify this problem further.

He has had no other particular problems with his haemophilia and has had no recent joint or muscle bleeds. He has required no dental treatment recently and has been otherwise very well.

I have taken blood to repeat full blood count, Factor VIII assays and hepato assays and have also repeated his hepatitis B status to see if he requires a booster injection of hepatitis B vaccine. We will write to you with these results if further vaccination is indicated. He will be reviewed at the Haemophilia Clinic in 6 months time, but should you have any problems in the interim please do not hesitate to get in touch.
