# Section 2: Response to criticism of witness W2287 in oral evidence

- Decisions such as these are very difficult and weigh heavily, not just in terms of the evidence before you as a minister, but also the knowledge that whatever decision is made will be impactful.
- 2. I watched and listened and read the work of the committee, I held a number of meetings to discuss the advice received and in turn received briefings from key officials and I felt that the decision taken was the appropriate one. I always took the view, both as an MSP and as a Minister, that it was our job to advocate on behalf of people and causes and I did that on this occasion and on many other occasions. On this occasion the balance was whether public value would be gained from an inquiry and, in good faith, and with a heavy heart knowing the implications of the decision, I did not support a public inquiry.

- 4. The Scottish Government including myself always took the view that should new evidence arise then that should be considered and that remains my position today.
