I provide this statement on behalf of NHS Lothian in response to a request under Rule 9 of the Inquiry Rules 2006 dated 12 August 2021.

I, Tracey Gillies, will say as follows: -

Section 2: Response to Criticism of W2663

Criticism of witness W2663

4. At paragraph 14 of witness W2663's statement, the witness states that the

staff of Edinburgh Royal Infirmary did not inform his wife that she had

received a blood transfusion in 1977.

It is difficult to determine what information was provided in 1977 as this was a

long time ago, and maternity records are not available for this patient. W2663

notes in paragraph 2 of his witness statement that his wife collapsed in a

bathroom after delivery with loss of blood. A collapse during or immediately

after childbirth can be associated with very significant blood loss and constitutes

an emergency. Blood transfusion may be required as part of resuscitation of

the patient, and in those circumstances communication may have been more

limited than it should have been in less urgent circumstances as the clinical

team will have focussed their attention on the care of W2663's wife.
