Sleepy, occasionally dosing off but currently comfortable and denying any pain or nausea Note concerns over swallow - dislikes the mouth sponges Note Ca now <3 Catheterised for urinary retention Explained to wife and SF that it looks like he is getting weaker with much less reserve, therefore more prone to delirium from small things (medications, urinary retention, hypercalcaemia). Urinary retention and swallow also likely to reflect general deterioration. Wife is desperate to take him home but I've advised that this will need to be reviewed in the coming days. I'm not sure how realistic this would be IMP Multifactorial delirium on background of significant frailty and decline from metastatic cancer Probably approaching end of life Plan Slow IV fluids whilst cannula in situ. Consider SC fluids if tissues Mouthcare Need to slowly think about withdrawing active measures, but I'm reluctant to do so all at once given that I've only met SF and his wife for the first time today.
