I have agreed with Mrs GRO-B oday that I will speak to her on the telephone next week. I have not arranged a further appointment in the Haematology Clinic at present.



When we met in clinic that day then there were factors that made me concerned about not only the weight loss that you have had but also possible history of fevers and some concerns about memory loss. When you and your husband phoned on 04 July 2012 you were concerned that these were not ongoing problems. As I explained to you both these are both very important features and may represent important problems in the context of HIV infection. Please would you review this further with Dr Sivaram if there is any doubt about whether or not you were having fevers then it would be sensible for you to record your temperature.
