4. Although I do not recall the actual conversation with this lady as it was many years ago. However, I always allocated a minimum of 1 hour to discuss side effects for patients. I went into great detail about the numerous side effects they may experience and how best to manage them. Thyroid dysfunction was one of the rarer ones although always mentioned. I always took great lengths to go through all the side effects, so that they did not come as a shock. They could be very debilitating and difficult for many patients who received the Interferonbased therapy. I also gave written information to support this.

5. Lots of patients who had Interferon treatment for Hepatitis C experienced hair loss.

This is of course extremely distressing. Many of the side effects are similar to those patients having chemotherapy.

I have been treating patients since 1996 and have a great deal of knowledge, experience & expertise. Although I cannot recall the actual conversation, I can honestly say I would never, ever say that to a patient, especially a female, regarding hair loss.

6. Lots of patients call long after the treatment is complete and I always, always provide any ongoing support required. I still speak to some patient who I treated up to ten or twelve years ago.
