14.1.82 Haematology review.

Mr Matharu has developed ecchymoses and oedema.

Although he has no palmar erythema, white
nails and spider naevi this must be attributed
to liver disease which is clearly more severe
than we had expected. Haemorrhages and
physical signs are unreliable indicators of
the severity of liver disease. Had we appreciated the
severity of his liver disease we would not have
proposed surgery in the first place.

Think that his recurrent bleed probably
reflects haemophilia, & fits with his liver disease
concomitant to liver disease.

I suggest :- kinetics approximately 100%
factor VIIIc → 50 - 100% .6.1
(4-5 bottles b.d.).

for next 2-3 wks.

U&E 10 mg a.e.

I will review tomorrow. Have told him his liver
disease (of which he is aware) has worsened and is
contributing to his bleeding tendency. I have spoken
