	Last week, Dr Ludlam wrote to Brial asking if it would be possible to obtain some of the BPL products for use if a previously untreated haemophilic presented for replacement therapy. He said it would be difficult to estimate his potential use accurately, but I understand that he has no haemophilics on his books at the moment who have not been treated. He has actually asked for 100,000 units, which I make 500 vials of 200 units in each. He says that this should be sufficient to cover surgery in such patients. But it strikes me that this is a considerable quantity, representing about half of a batch which would be produced from PFC. Before I write back to Christopher, would it be possible for you to obtain perhaps 10,000 - ie 50 vials which would at least enable us to cover the initial injection for such a case and if the need were to arise to call up more from 0xford over the course of 24 hours or so. I think that whereas a request for 10,000 units could be justified. However, even if this is difficult to get, how about 4,000 - ie 2 boxes with 10 vials in each? Kindest regards.
