I have recently been contacted by the above constituent of mine and have been given written consent from Mr [GRO-A] s son and daughter to act on their behalf and respond to their father. A copy of the consent form is enclosed.

Please also find enclosed copies of letters to the family from Mr David Body of Irwin Mitchell Solicitors, and from H B M Sayers at Guiti Martin Solicitors. The letter addressed to GRO-A was also sent to her brother, GRO-A

The letters, and therefore concerns of the GRO-A family, are self-explanatory and I believe they have a case. It appears to me that GRO-A and GRO-A are being unjustly treated given that, as outlined in David Body's letter, since obtaining a Grant of Probate/Letters of Administration/Confirmation was a pre-condition to making a claim for compensation, the Trustees should therefore be responsible for such costs.

Frankly, on the information I have been given from Mr $_{GRO-A}$ as to the extent of the involvement in the case from H B M Sayers, I find it astonishing that these children have been charged with legal costs of £1,263.93 at all.

It has also been brought to my attention that this cost is only concerned with the distribution of Estates in Scotland, given our particular legal system. If this is the case it only serves to compounds the inequity.
