

NOTE: HIV: LIST FOR DISCOVERY

A. Ask Jant Desai whether we can set back his 23/1/90 deadline, since service required not earlier than 31/1/90.

B. With regard to Armour documents in possession of LA/CSM, unless Counsel decides otherwise, we will include Armour documents in LA/CSM List for Discovery. At the conference with Counsel (16.30 17/1/90; 2 Crown Office Row) put this to Justin Fenwick.

C. Richard Gutowski to send down to Mark (by Friday?):

1. 2 policy files for scrutiny (cross check with HS1/lawyers for SoS);

2. List for discovery (check and then decide whether there is a need for Sol C5 to look through all the relevant documents - check perhaps with Peter Nilsson);

3. 15 documents Richard Gutowski classifies as 'doubtfuls'.

D. On Monday 22/1/90, HIV summons for directions. Endeavour to complete work on List by Tuesday 23/1/90.

E. Find out more about 'NIBS' (?) when policy files arrive. Richard thinks we should send it a note, as a matter of courtesy, if and when correspondence pertaining to it, is disclosed. I understand the body is funded by the Department. It may be that it is itself, therefore, subject to the order for discovery as part of the Department/SoS.
