Stephen Dorrell has shown me your letter of 2 November about the launch of the Greater Manchester World AIDS Day initiative. As Minister with policy responsibility for HIV and AIDS, I am happy to send you a message of support.

The challenges posed by HIV and AIDS require a response from all of us. I am therefore pleased to see that this initiative involves the statutory, voluntary and private sectors working together to get the World AIDS Day message across.

The theme for World AIDS day this year, "Shared Rights, Shared Responsibilities", highlights the fact that it is up to all of us to educate people against the view that HIV and AIDS are other peoples problems. The concerted approach we have taken spanning Government, the NHS, local authorities, and the voluntary sector has resulted in the UK having one of the lowest estimated AIDS prevalence rates in Western Europe.
