I feel that he could now stop prophylaxis for the time but warned him to be ready to start should he have a run of bleeds or some serious trouble with his knee.

I note that he received a variety of products at school, sometimes three different products within 2 or 3 days. With his history of allergy I think it would be wiser for them to stick to one product and would suggest Hemofil.
