

I am writing at the request of the Trust Executive Group of this Trust to ask you to consider issuing a national statement with respect to Pulmonate (macroaggregated albumin, technetium labelled, batches derived from a pool contributed to by a nvCJD subject). I enclose a copy of the paper prepared for the Trust Executive Group. The focus of attention in the Trust has been of whether or not to recall and counsel those who have received the product. The proposal in the paper (not to recall and counsel) was supported by the Trust Executive Group. We feel that for this sensible policy to work there needs to be complete national coherence and it was felt that (i) you might like to have this local support for non-recall and (ii) you would be in a position this as a general policy for the arguments summarised in the paper.
